After finished HCIS 2018, the accepted and presented papers in HCIS 2018, will be published to the special issues of the international journals by indexed SCI/SCIE (Level 1: High Impact Factor – Top ranked 25%: Q1, Web of Science; Level 2: SCI/SCIE journals).
